- 1) Academic performance,
- 2) Participation in extra-curricular and/or community service-based organizations,
- 3) Completeness of essay
- 4) Letters of recommendation
- 5) If all application instructions were followed correctly

In order to be considered as a candidate, please complete the application form and submit all required documents in the same pdf file, **submitted via email no later than May 5th, 2023**, as listed above.

The Scholarship recipient will be notified no later than one week prior to awards ceremony. The scholarship recipient will be honored at the Davis awards ceremony, date TBA. At that time, the recipient will be asked to say a few words to the Davis students.

- 2) Which Davis teacher had the most influence or impact on you? How did he/she contribute to your education and your subsequent contributions to school, family and community?

Three (3) Recommendation letters with each letter containing specific criteria for content.

- Letter from either a teacher or counselor who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate.
 This letter must contain candidate's overall participation in his/her education, academic standing and characteristics possessed by candidate that make him/her the best candidate for the Scholarship.
- 1) Letter from either extra-curricular or community service work contact who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate.
 - **This letter must contain -** information about candidate's participation/achievements in his/her organization, characteristics possessed by candidate that make him/her the best candidate for the Scholarship
- 1) Letter from a personal reference who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate on a more personal level (not a family member).
 - **This letter must contain** information about characteristics possessed by candidate that make him/her the best candidate for the Scholarship.
